NAET® AND BBF TREATMENT PROTOCOL

INTRODUCTION

The first step of NAET® (Nambudripad's allergy Elimination Technique) treatment procedure calls for Brain Body Balancing Treatment. BBF treatment is given in order to balance the energy of the body, to regulate the energy flow through all twelve meridians and to calm the brain and the meridians coursing through body and brain.

PROCEDURE

Balancing the patient's initial yin-yang balance and organ balance should be performed before checking for BBF.

Step-1: Test the first time patient to see if the patient produces a weak NST for BBF. If the NST is weak, treat the patient for BBF using NAET® treatment protocol. Ask the patient to return after 25 hours for the next treatment.

Step-2: On the next visit, retest the BBF. If it produced a strong NST, test for possible combinations and CMI (cellular memory imbalances) by QRT. If there was no indication for further treatment for BBF alone, then test the patient for the egg mix. If the egg mix in the patient's hand produced a weak NST, if the OCM permits the treatment for egg, treat the patient for egg mix. If the OCM does not permit the treatment for egg, find another item permitted by OCM.

Step-3: After NAET® spinal treatment, have the patient wait in the office for 20 minutes. During this 20 minutes-waiting period patient can receive gate point therapy either by massaging the gate points or using acupuncture (if the practitioner is licensed to apply acupuncture). After 20-

minutes' wait period, recheck the NST for egg mix sample, if the patient is producing a strong NST for egg mix, check the organs, levels and cellular memory imbalances. If everything is found normal, ask the patient to wash hands with plain water, send the patient home with the instructions to avoid egg and egg products. Ask the patient to return after 25 hours and/or within one week for rechecking the treated item and for possible next treatment.

Step-4: On the following visit, retest the patient for egg mix. If it is producing a weak NST, then continue to treat the egg until it produces a strong NST. If it is producing a strong NST, then add the BBF to the egg mix and retest. If the two samples together produces a strong NST, then the patient can be tested for the next item on the list (e.g. cal mix). If the two samples together produces a weak NST, treat them together, have the patient wait for ten minutes, then recheck. If it is producing a strong NST upon recheck, take the samples away from the patient's hand, ask the patient to wash the hands with plain water or rub both hands together vigorously for 30 seconds. Then check the patient for cal mix. If the cal mix is found to produce a weak NST, if the OCM check is OK to treat another item on that day, the patient can be treated for cal mix. Then follow step-3 onwards.

Step-5: On the next visit, retest the egg mix plus BBF, and retest cal mix alone. If both are found to produce strong NSTs, test for all the organs, levels, and any possible combinations. If all tests produce strong NST, then add the BBF to the cal mix and retest again. If the two samples together in the hand produces a strong NST, then the patient can be tested for the next item on the list (e.g. vit. C mix). If the cal mix and BBF

together produces a weak NST, treat the two samples together. Make the patient wait for ten minutes, recheck the cal mix and BBF together. If it is producing a strong NST, take the samples away from the patient's hand, ask the patient to wash the hands with plain water or rub both hands together for 30 seconds vigorously. Then the patient can be checked for vit. C mix and treated for vit. C if the OCM permits another treatment on that day. Then continue step-3 onwards. Continue through all basic 15 in this fashion.
